10 11	Amend the bill by adding before the Statement of Fact the following:
12	'In no event may an employer who otherwise could
13	not keep open a place of business to the public on a
14	Sunday, but who may keep that business open on Sun-
15	days between Thanksgiving and Christmas, require an
16 17	employee to work on a Sunday or Sundays, nor make
18	such a requirement a condition of employment. It shall not be considered just cause to dismiss an
19	employee or employees due solely to a refusal on the
20	part of the employee or employees to work on a Sunday
21	or Sundays.
22	An employer who could not keep open a place of
23	business to the public on a Sunday, but who may keep
24 25	that business open on Sundays between Thanksgiving
26	and Christmas, shall pay each employee working on Sunday 1 1/2 times the regular hourly wage rate for
27	each Sunday worked.'
28	STATEMENT OF FACT
29	This amendment allows an employee who does not
30	wish to work on a Sunday, due to family obligations,
31 32	religious convictions or other reason, to be excused from the requirement of work on the additional days
33	which a store may now be open under this bill. It
34	does not interfere with the hiring or scheduling
35	practices of stores which already may be open on Sun-
36	days. It also requires that employers who choose to
