18 and Museums from State Sales Tax.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§42 is enacted to read:

23 42. Historical societies and museums. Sales to
24 incorporated nonprofit historical societies and
25 museums.

26 STATEMENT OF FACT

27 The purpose of this bill is to exempt nonprofit
28 historical societies and museums from payment of
29 sales tax. It is estimated that enactment of such a
30 measure would result in a loss of \$13,500 for the
31 first year of the biennium and \$18,000 for the 2nd

1 year of the biennium. There would be no additional
2 administrative costs.
