26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34	Within a reasonable time before any election, the Secretary of State shall furnish each municipality with ballots, specimen ballots, instruction posters, election return forms, posters of specimen ballots for constitutional resolutions and statewide refer- enda, including the Attorney General's explanatory statements prepared under Title 1, section 353 ,posters setting forth the full text of all constitu- tional resolutions and statewide referenda and other

1 materials necessary for conducting and reporting the 2 results of the election.

3 Sec. 2. 21 MRSA §801, sub-§2, as amended by PL 4 1979, c. 534, §4, is further amended to read:

5 Election materials distributed and posted. At any time after receipt thereof and prior to the open-6 7 ing of the polls, the clerk may open the packages or 8 boxes of election materials, break the seals on the 9 packages not marked "ballots," use the materials for 10 instructional purposes, and then the clerk or his 11 designated agents shall post an adequate number of instruction posters, and posters of specimen ballots 12 for constitutional resolutions and statewide refer-13 enda, including the Attorney General's explanatory 14 statements prepared under Title 1, section 353, 15 posters setting out the full text of constitutional resolutions and statewide referenda, and specimen 16 17 18 ballots in the voting room outside the guardrail. At the opening of the polls, the warden shall break the 19 seals on the packages containing the ballots, and 20 21 distribute the ballots to the incoming election 22 clerks.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that the text of all constitutional resolutions and all statewide referenda be posted at each polling place throughout the State on election day.
