17 AN ACT to Clarify the Determination of
18 Axles on Motor Farm Trucks.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §439, as amended by PL 1981, c. 492, Pt.
23 A, §5, is further amended by adding at the end a new
24 paragraph to read:

25 For the purposes of this section, motor truck
26 means a farm motor truck or a farm motor truck haul-
27 ing a trailer, provided that the combined number of
28 axles does not exceed 3, and the truck or truck and
29 trailer is being used to convey agricultural commodi-
30 ties.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to clarify the determination of the number of axles on motor farm trucks. This will prevent violations when the farm motor truck is hauling a trailer and the trailer axle is included in determining the number of axles.

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
