**AN ACT to Remove the Retroactive
Provisions of the Income Tax Indexing Law.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 1982 initiated bill concerning income tax indexing is due to take effect immediately; and

Whereas, the retroactive provision of that bill, if allowed to take effect, would mean a \$32 million expense for the State; and

Whereas, if this retroactive provision is to be removed, it must be done before it takes effect; and
