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- B. The notice shall include the name and address of the surveyor.
- C. The notice shall be by mail to the person's last known address, as indicated in the most recent land tax listing.
- 2. Violation. Violation of this section is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$500 may be adjudged. Violation of this section shall also be grounds for the revocation of a registered land surveyor's certificate of registration in accordance with the provisions and procedures set out in section 1688.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require surveyors surveying any land to notify abutting landowners prior to making the survey. This allows abutting landowners to be aware of the survey and gives them an opportunity to produce any information that they may have and to voice any opinions on the lines so that the surveyor may weigh all the evidence and set the boundary lines as correctly as possible.

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
