17 AN ACT to Expand the Territorial Limits
18 of Van Buren Light and Power District.
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 P&SL 1917, c. 182, §1, as repealed and replaced
23 by P&SL 1979, c. 38, is repealed and the following
24 enacted in its place:

25 Sec. 1. Territorial limits; name; purposes; bond
26 issue authorized. The following described territory
27 and the people within the territory, namely all of
28 the Town of Van Buren, excepting that area contained
29 by original Lots 237 through 248, inclusive; and so
30 much of the Town of Hamlin as is included in original
31 Lots 306 through 309, inclusive; is hereby created a
32 body politic and corporate under the name of the Van
33 Buren Light and Power District; with the right of
34 making, generating, purchasing, selling, distributing

1 and supplying gas or electricity, or both, for light-
2 ing, heating, manufacturing or mechanical purposes,
3 and to sell the gas or electricity for street light-
4 ing purposes and to light all public and private
5 buildings, houses, stores, warehouses, mills and
6 business places in the district, and likewise for
7 heating, domestic and power purposes. The district
8 may build such system as may be required to carry out
9 the purposes stated in this section, or acquire by
10 purchase or the right of eminent domain any existing
11 system or systems and enlarge or extend the system or
12 systems as circumstances require. The district may
13 also issue bonds in such amount as may appear neces-
14 sary to fully accomplish these purposes with a view
15 to furnishing the inhabitants of the district with
16 gas and electricity for all purposes to which the
17 same may be advantageously applied.

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The purpose of this bill is to redefine the ter-
20 ritorial limits of the Van Buren Light and Power Dis-
21 trict.
