3	5-A. College or university students. A nonresi-
4	dent or alien may purchase any type of hunting or
5	fishing license or a combination hunting and fishing
6	license for the same fee charged for a resident li-
7	cense upon furnishing adequate proof to the clerk or
8	issuing agent that he is enrolled as a full-time
9	student at a college or university within the State.
10	For the purposes of this subsection, the term "full-
11	time" means that the student is enrolled for a mini-
12	mum of 24 credit hours each year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is to permit full-time 15 students attending colleges and universities within 16 the State to purchase hunting and fishing licenses at 17 the same fee as residents.
