17 AN ACT to Permit Nonresident Students
18 attending Maine Colleges and Universities on
19 a Full-time Basis to Purchase Resident Hunting
20 and Fishing Licenses.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7101, sub-§5-A is enacted to
25 read:

26 5-A. College or university students. A nonresi-
27 dent or alien may purchase any type of hunting or
28 fishing license or a combination hunting and fishing
29 license for the same fee charged for a resident li-
30 cence upon furnishing adequate proof to the clerk or
31 issuing agent that he is enrolled as a full-time
32 student at a college or university within the State.
33 For the purposes of this subsection, the term "full-
34 time" means that the student is enrolled for a mini-
35 imum of 24 credit hours each year.
