17 AN ACT to Require the City of Caribou to
18 Establish a Voting District in the Unorganized
19 Township of Connor.
20

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 21 MRSA §1573, sub-§1, ¶A, as repealed and
24 replaced by PL 1975, c. 774, §1, is amended to read:

25 A. Connor. The municipal officers of ~~Caswell~~
26 ~~Plantation~~ Caribou are directed to establish a
27 voting place at Connor, an unorganized township
28 in the County of Aroostook, for all state and
29 national elections, including primary elections,
30 at which voting place all residents of unorgan-
31 ized places entitled to vote in ~~Caswell~~
32 ~~Plantation~~ Caribou may cast their ballots under
33 the conditions provided in this section. The
34 municipal officers shall prepare a separate list

1 of such voters, resident in unorganized places
2 who are entitled to vote in Caswell Plantation
3 Caribou, as may request the privilege of voting
4 at Connor at the time they qualify as voters in
5 Caswell Plantation Caribou under section 246, and
6 all persons whose names are so included in that
7 list shall be entitled to vote at that voting
8 place in Connor instead of at Caswell Plantation
9 Caribou.

10 Municipal officers of Caswell Plantation Caribou
11 shall select 4 ballot clerks from the inhabitants
12 of Connor, representing the 2 political parties
13 which at the gubernatorial election next pre-
14 ceding such appointment cast the greatest number
15 of votes and shall select a warden who shall be a
16 resident of Caswell Plantation Caribou.

17 The conduct of elections at that voting place
18 shall be the same as in towns having separate
19 voting districts and all the provisions of the
20 Revised Statutes with respect to separate voting
21 districts in towns are made applicable to that
22 voting place at Connor as though the same were
23 located within the territorial limits of Caswell
24 Plantation Caribou. The powers and duties of
25 municipal officers in such case are conferred
26 upon the municipal officers of Caswell Plantation
27 Caribou.

28 STATEMENT OF FACT

29 This bill changes the responsibility for conduct-
30 ing elections in the unorganized township of Connor
31 from Caswell Plantation to Caribou.
