18 19 20	Whereas, it is vitally necessary that this legislation be enacted as an emergency to avoid the extra tax on fuel; and
21 22 23 24 25 26	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
27 28	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:
29 30 31	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
