HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 130, L.D. 138,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Motor Fuel Taxes."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting  
clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this bill freezes the amount of sales  
tax paid on certain fuel by political subdivisions at  
the January 1, 1983, rate; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that this legis-  
lation be enacted as an emergency to avoid the extra  
tax on fuel; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
therefore, '

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end  
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect  
when approved.'
