15 16 17 18	No refuse disposal facility may be located within the boundaries of any municipality unless the municipal officers of that municipality consent to the location of the facility in that municipality.
19 20 21	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

23 24 25 26	The purpose of this bill is to allow municipalities to exercise local control over the location of regional refuse disposal facilities within their boundaries.
