AN ACT to Prohibit the Location of a
Regional Refuse Disposal Facility in a
Municipality Without the Consent of the
Municipal Officers.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, under current law regional refuse disposal facilities may be located in a municipality without its approval; and

Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as emergency legislation, certain municipalities may be forced to accept disposal facilities within their boundaries which they do not desire; and
