

Amend the Resolve in the last paragraph before
the statement of fact in the 6th line (page 3, line
36 in L.D.) by striking out the figure and punctu-
ation "\$3,000,000," and inserting in its place the
figure and punctuation '\$300,000,'

maximum recovery for a successful suit against the
