17 AN ACT Relating to Minimum Payment to
18 Frye Island Municipal Services

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 P&SL 1975, c. 138, §9 is amended by adding after
24 the first sentence a new sentence to read:

25 The sum so appropriated shall not be less than 20% of
26 the town's raised taxation on those estates.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 Private and Special Law 1975, chapter 138,
29 section 9, is now permissive. The bill establishes a
30 required minimum payment to the Frye Island Municipal
31 Services Corporation. The only service provided by

1 the Town of Standish (except for evaluation and taxa-
2 tion) is the summer use of an equipped fire engine
3 and fire protection. Standish has consistently given
4 21% of its collected island taxes back to the island
5 to assist in supporting the operation of the ferry.
6 It is the desire of the trustees of the Frye Island
7 Municipal Service Corporation to be assured of a
8 firm yearly financial commitment from Standish.
