AN ACT to Set Off Part of Township A,  
Range 7 W.E.L.S. and Township 1, Range 7  
W.E.L.S. in the County of Penobscot, and  
Annex the Same to the Town of Millinocket.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the territory to be annexed is uninhabited and is under serious consideration for development for residential and commercial use; and

Whereas, it is desirable for the residents of the Town of Millinocket to vote on this matter at a meeting to be held in March, 1983; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

33

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine as  
6 follows:

7 **Sec. 1. Portion of unorganized township to be**  
8 **annexed.** All the following described territory now a  
9 part of Township A, Range 7 W.E.L.S. and Township 1,  
10 Range 7, W.E.L.S. in the County of Penobscot,  
11 together with the inhabitants and estates included in  
12 that territory, is hereby set off from that Township  
13 A, Range 7 and Township 1, Range 7, and annexed to  
14 and made a part of the Town of Millinocket namely:

15 A. Beginning at an iron pin and post in the  
16 southerly sideline of Route 157 on the town line  
17 between Township A, Range 7 and Millinocket;  
18 thence S  $69^{\circ} 14' 24''$  E by and along the southerly  
19 sideline of Route 157 one thousand one hundred  
20 eighty-eight (1188) feet to an iron pin and post;  
21 thence S  $5^{\circ} 04' 00''$  W by and along a painted line  
22 four thousand two hundred ninety-one and  
23 thirty-three one hundredths (4291.33) feet to an  
24 iron pin and post; thence N  $77^{\circ} 49' 46''$  W by and  
25 along a painted line one thousand one hundred  
26 ninety-six and twelve one hundredths (1196.12)  
27 feet to an iron pin and post in the town line  
28 between Township A, Range 7 and Millinocket;  
29 thence northerly along that town line four thou-  
30 sand four hundred sixty-four (4464) feet to an  
31 iron pin and post and the point of beginning.

32 **Sec. 2. Powers vested.** The inhabitants of the  
33 annexed territory are hereby vested with all the  
34 powers and subject to all the duties of other inhabi-  
35 tants of the Town of Millinocket.

36 **Sec. 3. Referendum.** This Act shall be submitted  
37 to the legal voters of the Town of Millinocket voting  
38 by ballot at a regular municipal election to be held  
39 in March 1983. The town clerk shall include in the  
40 ballot the following question:

1 "Shall part of Township A, Range 7 and Township  
2 1, Range 7 in the County of Penobscot be set off and  
3 annexed to the Town of Millinocket?"

4 Upon its acceptance by the majority of legal  
5 voters voting in that election, sections 1 and 2 of  
6 this Act shall take effect for all its various pur-  
7 poses 30 days after the town clerk certifies the  
8 results of the election. The town clerk shall file a  
9 certificate of the election with the Secretary of  
10 State.

11 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
12 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect  
13 when approved.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this bill is to annex small por-  
16 tions of Township A, Range 7 W.E.L.S. and Township 1,  
17 Range 7 W.E.L.S. to the Town of Millinocket.
