Whereas, these facts cre	in the judgment of the Legislature eate an emergency within the meaning of

the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. Portion of unorganized township to be 8 annexed. All the following described territory now a 9 part of Township A, Range 7 W.E.L.S. and Township 1. 10 7, W.E.L.S. in the County of Penobscot, Range 11 together with the inhabitants and estates included in 12 that territory, is hereby set off from that Township 13 Range 7 and Township 1, Range 7, and annexed to Α. 14 and made a part of the Town of Millinocket namely:

15 Beginning at an iron pin and post in the Α. 16 southerly sideline of Route 157 on the town line between Township A, Range 7 and Millinocket; thence S °69 14' 24" E by and along the southerly 17 18 19 sideline of Route 157 one thousand one hundred eighty-eight (1188) feet to an iron pin and post; 20 thence S 5° 04' 00" W by and along a painted line 21 22 four thousand two hundred ninety-one and thirty-three one hundredths (4291.33) feet to an iron pin and post; thence N 77° 49' 46" W by and 23 24 25 along a painted line one thousand one hundred 26 ninety-six and twelve one hundredths (1196.12) 27 iron pin and post in the town line feet to an 28 between Township A, Range 7 and Millinocket; thence northerly along that town line four thou-29 sand four hundred sixty-four (4464) feet to 30 an 31 iron pin and post and the point of beginning.

32 Sec. 2. Powers vested. The inhabitants of the 33 annexed territory are hereby vested with all the 34 powers and subject to all the duties of other inhabi-35 tants of the Town of Millinocket.

36 Sec. 3. Referendum. This Act shall be submitted 37 to the legal voters of the Town of Millinocket voting 38 by ballot at a regular municipal election to be held 39 in March 1983. The town clerk shall include in the 40 ballot the following question: 1 "Shall part of Township A, Range 7 and Township 2 1, Range 7 in the County of Penobscot be set off and 3 annexed to the Town of Millinocket?"

4 Upon its acceptance by the majority of legal 5 voters voting in that election, sections 1 and 2 of 6 this Act shall take effect for all its various pur-7 poses 30 days after the town clerk certifies the 8 results of the election. The town clerk shall file a 9 certificate of the election with the Secretary of 10 State.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this bill is to annex small por-16 tions of Township A, Range 7 W.E.L.S. and Township 1, 17 Range 7 W.E.L.S. to the Town of Millinocket.

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
