18 Property of Institutions and Organizations

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 36 MRSA §652, sub-§1, ¶M is enacted to read:

24 M. Privately owned real estate and related fix-  
25 tures and personal property used as an outdoor  
26 stadium, if these facilities are of new  
27 construction commenced after January 1, 1983, pro-  
28 vided that the stadium contains seating for a  
29 minimum of 6,000 spectators, employs a minimum of  
30 35 seasonal employees and is available for use by  
31 baseball teams representing public high schools  
32 and state universities without charge to these  
33 educational institutions.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts certain privately owned real estate and related fixtures.
