STATEMENT OF FACT

19

This amendment corrects 2 errors in the title of
the bill, which also appeared in the bill's statement
of fact, referring to use of an "open cup" test,
rather than a "closed cup" test, as stated in the
text of the bill and current law. The title and
statement of fact also erroneously said that the bill
allows sale of oils which flash "under" 100 degrees;
in fact, the bill allows sale of oils which flash
over 100 degrees.
