SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 81, L.D. 192,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Training Penobscot Law
9 Enforcement Officers."

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
11 the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,
12 line 22 in L.D.) the abbreviation and figure
13 'Sec. 1.'

14

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
15 Statement of Fact the following:

16

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall not be
17 effective unless, within 60 days of the adjournment
18 of the Legislature, the Secretary of State receives
19 written certification by the governor and council of
20 the Penobscot Nation that the nation has agreed to
21 the provisions of this Act pursuant to the United
22 States Code, Title 25, Section 1725 (e)(1), copies of
23 which shall be submitted by the Secretary of State to
24 the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the
25 House; provided that in no event may this Act become
26 effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
27 Legislature.'
