20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 30 MRSA §6210, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1979, c.
23 732, §§1 and 31, is amended to read:

24 4. Powers and training requirements. Law
25 enforcement officers appointed by the Passamaquoddy
26 Tribe and the Penobscot Nation shall possess the same
27 powers and shall be subject to the same duties,
28 limitations and training requirements as ~~municipal~~
29 ~~police~~ other corresponding law enforcement officers
30 under the laws of the State.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill merely clarifies the law so that members of the Penobscot Police Department will receive the training of municipal police officers and that Penobscot Wardens will be able to receive the training of State Game Wardens which they currently do not receive, under the law's present wording.

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
