B. If the commissioner establishes such a program In establishing the program the commissioner shall:

- (1) He shall prescribe Prescribe the qualifications of instructors. Each instructor authorized by the commissioner to conduct these programs shall be covered by liability insurance protecting him from liability for damages during the time when instruction is being given. The cost of this insurance shall be borne by the State and shall be a charge against the funds credited to the department;
- (2) He shall preseribe Prescribe the type and course of instruction and the time and place of examinations; and
- (3) He shall issue <u>Issue</u> a certificate of competency to <u>miners individuals</u> who successfully complete the examination.
- 20 Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7071, sub-§7 is enacted to 21 read:
 - 7. Hunter safety course. All persons applying for any Maine firearm hunting license other than a juvenile license shall show proof of having successfully completed a hunter safety course as provided by chapter 703, or a hunter safety course which is equivalent or satisfactory proof of previously holding a firearms hunting license issued to him from this State, any other state, province or country in any year beginning with 1975.
- When proof of competency cannot be provided, the hunter may substitute a signed notarized affadavit that he has held the required license or that he successfully completed a Maine hunter safety course or its equivalent.
- 36 Sec. 4. Effective date. Section 3 of this Act 37 is effective on January 1, 1984.
