COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 170,  
L.D. 200, Bill, "AN ACT Limiting Positions of Trust  
for Prisoners in Jails to those Prisoners Sentenced  
or Transferred to that Particular Jail."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§952-A."  
in the 4th, 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 29 to 31  
in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "or to  
people under sentence from other institutions trans-  
ferred to their particular facility" and inserting in  
their place the underlined words 'or who was trans-  
ferred to that particular jail from another correc-  
tional facility where he was serving a sentence'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the  
language of the bill. The intent of the bill is to  
provide that prisoners in county jails, whether they  
were sentenced to that particular jail or whether  
they were transferred to that jail from another cor-  
rectional facility, may be granted positions of trust  
by sheriffs. Current law only provides for positions  
of trust for prisoners actually sentenced to the  
county jail. This amendment alters the wording of  
the bill to make its intent clear.
