STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to address the situation where a utility's request for a rate increase is denied on procedural grounds and not on the basis that the utility does not need a rate increase. In such a situation, the utility would be allowed to cure the procedural problem and refile without waiting for a year from the original filing.
