1 the tolls, such tolls to be reimbursed where Legis-2 lators use the Maine Turnpike in traveling to and from sessions of the Legislature or in performance of duly authorized committee assignments. Each Legis-3 4 5 lator shall be issued a turnpike pass, in a form prescribed by the Legislative Council, which shall 6 7 that Legislator to travel on the Maine Turnentitle 8 pike without payment of any tolls, provided that the Legislator is traveling in a vehicle which displays a 9 legislative license plate. Each Legislator is enti-10 11 tled to mileage on the first day of the session, and such amounts of his salary and expenses at such times 12 the Legislature may determine during the session, 13 as and the balance at the end thereof. 14

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 The purpose of this bill is to create a pass for 17 Maine Legislators to permit unlimited free travel on 18 the Maine Turnpike. In order for the pass to be 19 honored, a Legislator must be driving a motor vehicle 20 with the specially assigned legislative plates 21 attached thereto.

In fulfilling legislative duties, many Legislators find it necessary to travel on the Maine Turnpike. The present system of reimbursing Legislators
for toll charges is cumbersome and unnecessary.
