COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 102,
7 L.D. 234, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Charter of
8 the Van Buren Water District."

9 Amend the Bill on page 2 by striking out all of
10 lines 23 to 27 and inserting in their place the fol-
11 lowing:

12 'Sec. 5. Board of trustees. All the affairs of
13 the district shall be managed by an elected board of
14 3 trustees, residents of the district. They shall
15 hold office as provided in this section and until
16 their respective successors are elected and quali-
17 fied.'

18 Further amend the Bill on page 3 by striking out
19 all of lines 28 to 31 and inserting in their place
20 the following:

21 '5. Trustees' compensation. The trustees shall
22 receive compensation as recommended by them and
23 approved by a majority of the municipal officers of
24 the municipality, including compensation for any
25 duties they perform as officers, as well as for their
26 duties as trustees. Certification thereof shall be
27 recorded with the Secretary of State and recorded in
28 the bylaws. Their compensation for duties as
29 trustees shall be on the basis of such specified
30 amount as may be specified in the bylaws, not less
31 than \$5 and not more than \$10 for each board meeting
32 actually attended and reimbursement for travel and
33 expenses, with the total not to exceed such specific
34 amount as may be specified in the bylaws.'

35 Further amend the Bill on page 3 in line 41 by
36 striking out the underlined word "alternations" and
37 inserting in its place the underlined word
38 'alterations'
