21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23 24	3 MRSA §2, 9th ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c. 702, Pt. X, §5, is further amended to read:
25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	The President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the floor leaders and their assistants and members of a committee, with the approval of the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House as to members of a committee, may also meet on days when the Legislature is not in daily session at any convenient location within the State. Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall receive \$35 for every day's attendance when meetings or daily sessions are held, a meal

and housing allowance in the amount of \$45 for each day in attendance at such meetings or daily sessions and for each day he occupies overnight accommodations away from home either immediately preceding immediately following attendance at daily sessions of the Legislature and actual daily mileage allowances which shall be paid at the same rate paid to state employees. In lieu of the meal and housing allowance, each member shall be entitled to a daily meal allowance in the amount of \$21 and actual daily mileage allowances in an amount up to but not exceeding \$24 per day. Any Legislator who attends a meeting on a county budget shall receive \$12.50 for each day in attendance at that meeting and actual daily mileage allowances which shall be paid at the same rate paid to state employees. In lieu of the meal and housing allowance, the Legislator shall be entitled to a daily meal allowance in the amount of \$12 and actual daily mileage allowances in an amount up to but not exceeding \$13 per day.
