17 AN ACT to Make the Photographic Drivers'  
18 License Optional Rather than Mandatory.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §540, first ¶, as repealed and replaced  
23 by PL 1981, c. 506, §3, is amended to read:

24 Each license shall state the name, date of birth,  
25 place of residence of the licensee, permanent number  
26 assigned him, and may contain such other information  
27 as the Secretary of State deems necessary. The li-  
28 cense ~~shall~~ may, if the licensee requests it, also  
29 bear a photograph of the licensee for the purpose of  
30 identification ~~except that persons who renew their~~  
31 ~~licenses on or after their 65th birthday, persons in~~  
32 ~~active military service stationed outside the State~~  
33 ~~and temporary licenses issued under section 533 may~~  
34 ~~be exempt from the photograph requirement.~~

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to change the photo-graphic drivers' license law so that the picture is optional rather than mandatory.

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
