18 Audible Warning when Passing in a

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 29 MRSA §1151-B, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 30,  
24 §3, is repealed.

25 STATEMENT OF FACT

26 This bill repeals statutory provisions requiring  
27 the operator of a motor vehicle to sound his horn or  
28 flash his lights at night before passing another  
29 motor vehicle. These provisions are not enforceable  
30 and are of questionable effect as safety regulations.

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
