20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §545-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL
23 1977, c. 620, §2, is amended to read:

24 5. Persons 65 years of age or older. Any person
25 who has attained his 65th birthday ~~but has not~~
26 ~~attained his 75th birthday~~ shall pass the vision por-
27 tion of a driver's license examination before his li-
28 cense may be renewed.

29 Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §545-B, as enacted by PL 1977,
30 c. 620, §3, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to repeal the driver's test requirement for persons 75 years of age or older who renew their drivers' licenses.

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
