SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 110, L.D. 262,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Conform Maine Garnishment Laws to  
the United States Code, Title 15, Section 1673, the  
Federal Consumer Credit Protection Act."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and  
before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this legislation is necessary to allow  
increased garnishment to take place immediately; and

Whereas, the bill will allow individuals as well  
as the State to obtain money sooner; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
therefore,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end  
before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect  
when approved.'
