17 AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Violations
18 within the Penobscot Nation.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §2241, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced
23 by PL 1981, c. 689, §2, is amended to read:

24 2. Regulations. For the purpose of identifying
25 habitually reckless or negligent drivers and habitual
26 or frequent violators of traffic regulations govern-
27 ing the movement of vehicles, the Secretary of State
28 shall adopt regulations establishing a uniform system
29 of assigning demerit points for convictions or adju-
30 dications of violations of statutes or regulations
31 governing the operation of motor vehicles, including
32 violations of Title 17-A, section 360, subsection 1,
33 paragraphs A and B and Title 28, section 1002. The

1 regulations adopted by the Secretary of State shall
2 include a designated level of point accumulation
3 which so identifies drivers. The Secretary of State
4 shall assess points for convictions or adjudications
5 of violations of these statutes or regulations
6 obtained pursuant to Title 30, section 6209 and may
7 assess points for convictions or adjudications in
8 other states of offenses which, if committed in this
9 State, would be grounds for such that assessment.
10 Notice of assessment of points shall be given when
11 the point accumulation reaches 50% of the number at
12 which suspension is authorized. No points may be
13 assessed for violating a provision of this Title or
14 municipal ordinance regulating standing, parking,
15 equipment, size or weight.

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

17 This bill allows the Secretary of State to assess
18 points for violations of motor vehicle laws within
19 the Penobscot Nation which he cannot now do.

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
