20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §6209, sub-§1, ¶¶D and E, as
23 enacted by PL 1979, c. 732, §1, is amended to read:

24 D. Indian child custody proceedings to the
25 extent authorized by applicable federal law; and

26 E. Other domestic relations matters including
27 marriage, divorce and support between members of
28 either tribe or nation both of whom reside on the
29 Indian reservation of the respective tribe or
30 nation; and

31 Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §6209, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to
32 read:

1 F. Violations of statutes or regulations govern-
2 ing the operation of motor vehicles, including
3 violations of Title 17-A, section 360, subsection
4 1, paragraphs A and B, and Title 28, section
5 1002, but not including Title 29, chapter 18-A,
6 committed on the Penobscot Indian Reservation by
7 a member of either tribe or nation.

8 STATEMENT OF FACT

9 This bill addresses an area in which the tribal
10 court already exercises jurisdiction, but which the
11 Penobscot Nation believes should be clarified.

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
