1 Vehicles equipped and used for plowing snow on other 2 than public ways may be equipped with an auxiliary 3 rotary flashing light, which shall be mounted on top of the vehicle in such a manner as to emit an amber 4 beam of light over a 360° angle. Such lighting shall 5 6 only be in use on a public way when the vehicle is 7 entering in or upon such public ways in the course of 8 plowing private driveways and other off-highway loca-9 tions.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This bill allows wreckers providing service to 12 disabled vehicles on either the Maine Turnpike or interstate highways to use flashing red instead of flashing amber lights. Flash 13 lights 14 Flashing red 15 lights will be more visible to approaching motorists, 16 thereby providing a greater margin of safety for the passengers of the disabled vehicle and the wrecker 17 18 operator.
