Any person who violates any of the provisions of this
subsection is guilty of a Class D crime and shall be
sentenced to pay a fine of \$100 for a first offense
or be imprisoned for a period of 30 days; a fine of
\$500 for a 2nd offense or be imprisoned for a period
of 60 days; a fine of \$1,000 for a 3rd or subsequent
offense or be imprisoned for a period of 90 days.

6. The imposition or execution of any sentence imposed under subsection 5 may not be suspended and probation may not be granted.
