6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 243,  
7 L.D. 290, Bill, "AN ACT Regarding Courses and their  
8 Equivalency Offered at Various Units of the Univer-  
9 sity of Maine."

10 Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out the  
11 first 2 lines (page 2, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) and  
12 inserting in their place the following:

13 '§10907. Transfer of credits; uniform course num-  
14 bering; uniform course description; commit-  
15 tee.'

16 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part  
17 designated "§10907" in subsection 1, paragraph B,  
18 last line (page 2, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out  
19 the underlined word "and"

20 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part  
21 designated "§10907" in subsection 1, paragraph C,  
22 last line (page 2, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out  
23 the underlined word and punctuation "Maine." and  
24 inserting in their place the underlined word and  
25 punctuation 'Maine;'

26 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part  
27 designated "§10907" in subsection 1 by adding after  
28 paragraph C the following:

29 'D. The Vice-chancellor of Academic Affairs of  
30 the University of Maine to serve as an ex officio  
31 member; and

32 E. One member of the joint standing committee of  
33 the Legislature having jurisdiction over educa-  
34 tion to serve as an ex officio member and to be  
35 selected by the chairmen of the joint standing  
36 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction  
37 over education.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 243, L.D. 290

1 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part  
2 designated "§10907" by striking out all of subsection  
3 2 and inserting in its place the following:

4 '2. Chairman. The committee shall elect one of  
5 its members as chairman.'

6 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part  
7 designated "§10907" by striking out all of subsection  
8 5 and inserting in its place the following:

9 '5. Report and implementation. The committee  
10 shall report the results of its deliberations and its  
11 recommendations to the Board of Trustees of the Uni-  
12 versity of Maine no later than one year from the  
13 effective date of this subsection, as amended. The  
14 trustees shall implement the recommendations no later  
15 than the beginning of the fall semester of 1985.'

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

17 This amendment:

18 1. Adds a member of the joint standing committee  
19 of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education  
20 to the committee establishing a uniform course num-  
21 bering system;

22 2. Retains the vice-chancellor as an ex officio  
23 member of the committee but specifies that it be the  
24 Vice-chancellor of Academic Affairs; and

25 3. Sets the deadline for filing the report at  
26 one year from the effective date of Title 20-A,  
27 section 10907, subsection 5.
