- 15. Transfer of credits. To provide for a uniform system of transferring credits for equivalent courses between the various units of the University of Maine;
 - 16. Uniform course numbering. To provide for a uniform system of the numbering of courses for equivalent courses between the various units of the University of Maine; and
- 11 17. Uniform course descriptions. To provide for a uniform system of course descriptions for equivalent courses between the various units of the University of Maine.
- Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §10907 is enacted to read:
- 16 §10907. Transfer of credits; uniform course num-17 bering; uniform course descriptions; committee
- 18 <u>1. Formation. The Chancellor of the University</u> 19 of Maine shall form a committee composed of:
- A. The Dean of Academic Affairs or designee from each campus of the University of Maine;
 - B. One faculty member selected by the faculty from each campus of the University of Maine; and
- 24 C. One student representative selected by the student body of each campus of the University of Maine.
- 27 2. Chairman. The Vice-Chancellor of the Univer-28 sity of Maine shall serve as chairman and be an ex 29 officio member of the committee.
- 30 3. Meetings. The committee shall be selected as soon as reasonably possible after the effective date of this section. The Vice-Chancellor of Academic Affairs shall notify all members of the time and place of the first meeting. At that time, the committee shall organize and adopt rules as to the administration of its affairs. The members shall

- 1 serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed
 2 by the chancellor for travel expenses.
- 3 4. Duties. The committee shall establish:
- A. A uniform system to facilitate the transfer of credits for equivalent courses between the various units of the University of Maine;
- B. Development of a uniform course numbering system; and
- 9 C. Development of uniform course descriptions to
 10 provide an easy comparison of courses offered
 11 between the various units of the University of
 12 Maine.
- 5. Report. The committee shall report the results of its deliberations and its recommendations to the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine no later than January 1, 1984. The board shall implement the recommendations contained in the report.

20 This bill establishes a committee of individuals 21 from the various units of the University of Maine to: 1). Establish a uniform system of transferring cred-22 23 its for equivalent courses between those units; 2). Establish a uniform course numbering systems for the 24 25 units of the University of Maine; and 3). Develop 26 uniform course descriptions for all the units of the 27 university.

Students who have transferred from one unit of the University of Maine to another have lost credit hours and, in effect, money for the failure of one unit to accept credit hours from another for similar courses.
