7	Bill, "AN ACT to Provide an Income Tax Checkoff for
8	Voluntary Support of Nongame Wildlife Management."
9	Amend the bill by striking out all of the title
10	and inserting in its place the following:
11	'AN ACT to Provide an Income Tax Checkoff for
12	Voluntary Support of Nongame Wildlife Management and
13	Soil and Water Conservation Districts.'
14 15	Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:
16	'Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §5283, as enacted by PL 1973,
17	c. 246, is repealed and the following enacted in its
18	place:
19	§5283. Checkoff contributions
20	1. Political parties. Every individual resi-
21	dent, who is entitled to a refund under this Part,
22	may designate that \$1 of the refund be paid over to
23	any specified political party, as defined in Title
24	21, section 1, subsection 21. Every individual resi-
25	dent who is entitled to no refund under this Part may
26	add \$1 to his tax liability to be paid over to any
27	specified political party, as defined in Title 21,
28	section 1, subsection 21.
29	2. Soil and water conservation districts. Every
30	individual, who is entitled to a refund under this
31	Part, may designate that \$1 or \$5 of the refund be
32	paid over to the State Soil and Water Conservation
33	Commission, as defined in Title 12, section 3, sub-
34	section 1, for distribution in equal shares to the
35	soil and water conservation districts, as defined in
36	Title 12, section 3, subsection 2. Every individual

1	who is entitled to no refund under this Part may add
2	\$1 or \$5 to his tax liability to be paid over to the
3	State Soil and Water Conservation Commission for dis-
4	tribution in equal shares to the soil and water con-
5	servation districts.'
6	Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
7	tions to read consecutively.
8	STATEMENT OF FACT
9	This amendment establishs an income tax checkoff
10	provision for the benefit of the state's soil and
11	water conservation districts similar to the checkoff
12	currently permitted for the benefit of political par-
13	ties.
