20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7101, sub-§5, ¶A, as repealed
23 and replaced by PL 1981, c. 414, §11, is amended to
24 read:

25 A. Resident junior hunting license ~~§1~~ §4

26 (10 years of age or older and under 16)

27 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7133, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by
28 PL 1979, c. 729, §2, is amended to read:

29 B. Resident junior trapping ~~§5~~ §4

30 (10 years of age or older and under 16 years)

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to equalize the fees charged for resident junior hunting licenses and resident junior trapping licenses. The fee for both types of licenses would be \$4.

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
