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With respect to weeks of unemployment begin-D. ning after June 30, 1979, benefits shall be denied to an individual who performed services in an educational institution while in the employ of an educational service agency for any week which 24 commences during a period described in paragraphs and C if that individual performs any ser-Α, В vices described in paragraphs paragraph A or B in the 28 the first of these periods, as specified in 29 applicable paragraph, and there is a contract or 30 a reasonable assurance as applicable in the appropriate paragraph, that the individual will 32 perform these services in the 2nd of these 33 periods, as applicable in the appropriate para-34 graph.
