Any person who places, discharges or leaves any offensive or injurious matter or material on or in the sewer conduits, sewer catch-basins or sewer receptacles of the district contrary to its sewer use regulations, or knowingly injures any conduit, pipe, reservoir, flush tank, catch-basin, manhole, outlet, engine, pump or other property held, owned or used by the district for sewer purposes, is liable to pay twice the amount of the damage to the district, to be recovered in any proper action, and that person is
