the district for the purposes of this Act, shall be liable to pay twice the amount of the damages to said the district, to be recovered in any proper action; and such person; on conviction of any said acts of willful injury aforesaid; shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$300; or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days; or by both such fine and imprisonment, and that person shall be guilty of a Class E crime.

9 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the charter of the Augusta Sanitary District by making willful destruction of property of the district a Class E crime. The current charter already makes the offense punishable by a fine or imprisonment. This bill upgrades that language to bring the penalty provision into conformity with the designation of crimes used in the Maine Criminal Code.

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
