STATEMENT OF FACT

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25 26 Present law requires that a mechanics' lien against vehicles for labor, materials and storage be filed with the clerk of the city or town in which the vehicle owner resides. In the past, mortgages on vehicles were also filed with the municipal clerk. In 1978 the Legislature required that such mortages be filed with the Secretary of State. This bill treats the filing of mechanics' liens on vehicles the same as mortgages on vehicles by requiring both be filed with the Secretary of State.

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
