17 AN ACT Concerning Registration of Deer
18 in Unorganized Territories.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7458, sub-§4-A, as enacted by PL 1979,
23 c. 723, §18-E, is amended to read:

24 4-A. Keeping an unregistered deer. A person is
25 guilty, except as provided in subsection 15, para-
26 graph G, of keeping an unregistered deer if he keeps
27 an unregistered deer at his home, or at any place of
28 storage except a deer registration station, more than
29 12 hours; except that an unregistered deer may be
30 kept no more than 24 hours in an unorganized ter-
31 ritory.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to increase the time
3 you may keep an unregistered deer in an unorganized
4 territory from 12 hours to 24 hours.
