Amend the Bill in section 1 in paragraph A by
striking out in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 29
and 30 in L.D.) the underlined words "be a lifetime
license" and inserting in their place the following:
'remain valid through December 31st of the 2nd com-
plete calendar year following the year of issuance'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of
section 2.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 3
to be section 2.

This amendment extends the license to a 3-year
period and makes the registration date concurrent
with the expiration of all hunting and fishing
licenses and allows for a single annual mailing of
computerized renewal forms.
