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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 268, L.D. 328,  
Bill, "AN ACT to End Discrimination Against Chiro-  
practic Services under the Workers' Compensation  
Law."

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Amend the Bill by striking out everything after  
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the  
following:

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'39 MRSA §52, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1977, c.  
612, §5, is further amended to read:

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An employee sustaining a personal injury arising  
out of and in the course of his employment, provided  
~~said~~ that injury relates to a lumbar, sacral, dorsal  
or cervical subluxation shall be entitled to chiro-  
practic examination and treatment for the relief  
thereof. ~~Such~~ This treatment shall consist of  
palpating and adjusting the segments and articula-  
tions of the human spinal column by hand and shall  
include hydrotherapy, electrical therapy, ultrasound  
treatment and the provision of back support devices  
or mechanisms. Examination may include diagnostic x  
rays. A duly licensed chiropractor shall be consid-  
ered competent to testify before the Workers' Compen-  
sation Commission.'
