The Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages estimates that
this amendment will result in a loss of revenue to
the General Fund of \$11,000,000 each year, assuming
no increase in sales. In order to produce additional
revenue to offset this decrease, the current sales of
\$65,940,000 will have to increase to \$120,000,000.
The bureau also indicates that it will not be able to
accommodate such an increase with present staff or
facilities. The bureau estimates that sales would
have to be further increased to \$140,000,000 to cover
this additional cost to still produce the same reve-
nue as now. The bureau does not see such a scenario
as possible.'
