10 11	Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:
12 13	'AN ACT to Require Discount Liquor Prices Throughout the State.'
14 15 16	Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:
17 18	$\ensuremath{^{'}28}$ MRSA §451, as amended by PL 1979, c. 307, is further amended to read:
19	§451. Consumers' tax
20	All spirits and wines, except table wines, shall
21 22	be sold by the commission at a price to be determined by the commission which will produce a state liquor
23	tax of net less than 75% 45% based on the less car-
24	load cost F.O.B., State Liquor Commission warehouse,
25	and in addition thereto there shall be levied and
26	imposed an excise tax of 75¢ per gallon, or its met-
27	ric equivalent, on wines containing more then 14%
28 29	alcohol by volume; except that spirits and wines sold
29 30	at wholesale under section 204 may be sold at whole- sale prices established pursuant to the provisions
31	thereof. Prices for sale of spirits and wines bought
32	by the commission from Maine licensees to manufacture
33	liquor under section 501 shall be based on minimum
34	truck load delivery prices F.O.B. warehouse as the
35	same are filed with the Public Utilities Commission.

chandise shall be priced at not less than 75% 45% 1 2 over actual cost delivered F.O.B. warehouse. In all 3 cases the commission is authorized to round off costs the next highest 5 cents. Any increased federal 4 5 taxes levied on or after November 1, 1941 shall be 6 added to the established price without markup. All 7 net revenue derived from such tax shall be deposited 8 to the credit of the General Fund of the State. Not-9 withstanding the other provisions of this section, 10 the commission, with approval of the Commissioner of 11 Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of 12 discontinued items of liquor. The reduced price shall not be less than the actual cost of the discon-13 14 tinued liquor items and no item shall be discontinued 15 by the commission for a period of at least 6 months 16 after such item has been listed and on sale in state 17 stores. Netwithstanding the other previsions of this 18 section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, 19 20 reduce the price of liquor in one store, and licen-21 sees permitted to purchase liquor at a discount under 22 section 204 may purchase liquor for resale from that 23 store at the same price they are permitted to pur-24 chase liquor for resale from any state store which does not offer a retail discount. 25

Taxes on spirituous or vinous liquors imposed by the State shall not apply to spirituous or vinous liquors sold by wholesalers, manufacturers, bottlers and rectifiers holding licenses from the commission to any instrumentality of the United States, or to any vessel of foreign registry, or to industrial establishments for use as an ingredient in the manufacture of food products, or for use as an ingredient in the manufacture of commodities which by reason of their nature cannot be used for beverage purposes. The commission is specifically authorized to make such rules and regulations as they deem necessary for carrying out the provisions of this paragraph.

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission may, from time to time,

1 2 3 4 5	establish special prices on certain listed liquor items to be made available to the consumer at all state stores. Such special prices shall not be lower than the price established for the same listed item at the one authorized special discount state store.'
6	STATEMENT OF FACT
7 8 9 10 11 12 13	The purpose of this amendment is to achieve liquor price equity throughout the State by lowering all state liquor store prices to the price levels currently in effect at the Kittery store. The Kittery store sells liquor now at approximately 45% above the delivered warehouse price while the remainder of the state stroes sell at least at a 75% markup. This amendment lowers the markup to 45% statewide.
