wholesale under section 204 may be sold at wholesale established pursuant to the provisions thereof. Prices for sale of spirits and wines bought by the commission from Maine licensees to manufacture liquor under section 501 shall be based on minimum load delivery prices F.O.B. warehouse as the same are filed with the Public Utilities Commission. Special orders by the commission for unstocked merchandise shall be priced at not less than 75% actual cost delivered F.O.B. warehouse. In all cases commission is authorized to round off costs to the next highest 5 cents. Any increased federal taxes levied on or after November 1, 1941 shall be added to the established price without markup. All net revenue derived from such tax shall be deposited to the of the General Fund of the State. credit Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, commission, with approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of discontinued items of liquor. The reduced price shall not be less than the actual cost of the discontinued liquor items and no item shall be discontinued by the commission for a period of at least such item has been listed and on sale in state after stores. Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval θ£ Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in one store, and lieensees there are established discount liquor stores in Kittery, Sanford and Fryeburg at which the commission may reduce the price of liquor. Licensees permitted to purchase liquor at a discount under section 204 may purchase liquor for resale from that store at the same price they are permitted to purchase liquor for resale from any state store which does not offer a retail discount.

Taxes on spirituous or vinous liquors imposed by the State shall not apply to spirituous or vinous liquors sold by wholesalers, manufacturers, bottlers and rectifiers holding licenses from the commission to any instrumentality of the United States, or to any vessel of foreign registry, or to industrial establishments for use as an ingredient in the manufacture of food products, or for use as an ingredient in the manufacture of commodities which by reason of their nature cannot be used for beverage purposes.

The commission is specifically authorized to make such rules and regulations as they deem necessary for carrying out the provisions of this paragraph.

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission may, from time to time, establish special prices on certain listed liquor items to be made available to the consumer at all state stores. Such special prices shall not be lower than the price established for the same listed item at the ene 3 authorized special discount state stere stores.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

 The purpose of this bill is to establish discount liquor stores in Sanford and Fryeburg, as well as in Kittery. Both Sanford and Fryeburg are border towns with New Hampshire, as is Kittery, and both communities enjoy substantial tourist traffic. Also, by placing discount liquor stores in these communities, Maine residents in these areas will be less inclined to travel into New Hampshire to purchase their liquor.
